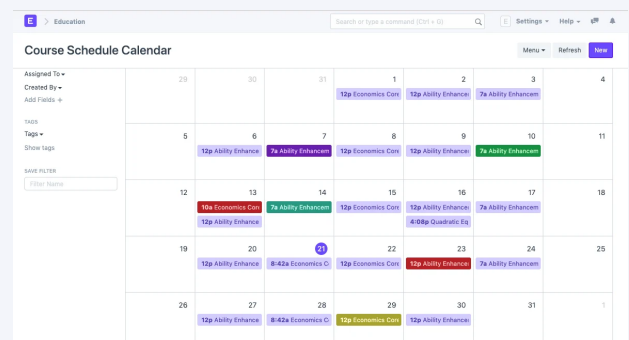

01 Understand the institution

Confirm campuses, academic structure, users, priorities and the modules needed.

02 Configure and connect

Map institutional processes, access rights, records, reporting and required integrations.

03 Prepare the people and data

Plan migration, validate data, provide user guidance and train the responsible teams.

04 Roll out and improve

Agree support, escalation and service commitments. Align AI teaching assistance and automation with the priorities of your institution.

Clear scope. Honest expectations.
